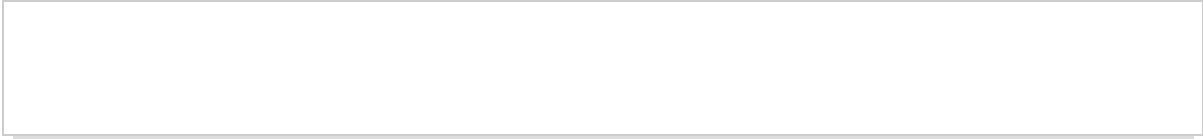
Thank you very much for choosing Cabins by the Caves for your Hocking Hills lodging accommodation! The management and staff here look forward to your arrival. Currently the Hocking Hills State Parks are not open. There is a list of nature preserves and parks that are available for hiking activities listed on the link on the homepage of our website. We value our guests, staff, and our community. We are diligently working here and in response to the COVID-19 pandemic you can expect the following:

- o We have temporarily removed throw pillows and extra blankets
- o We provide complete linen changing
- o Plastic hampers have been replaced with cloth laundry bags. Be kind to our housekeeping staff and place your soiled linens and towels in the laundry bags provided. Units that have washer and dryer access, please place your soiled linens inside the washer, please DO NOT SHAKE DIRTY LAUNDRY
- o Due to limited supplies you may wish to bring your own hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes. We are rigorously cleaning with a hospital grade disinfectant and placing even more emphasis on high touch areas
- o Please remember to wash your hands before unloading dishes from the dishwasher and putting them away
- o If preferred, you may consider bringing paper plates and plastic utensils to use during the course of your stay
- o Temporarily we have removed the possible high touch items such as board games, puzzles and DVD's if you would like to bring your own
- o We provide a contact free check in
- o Extended stays of three or more days will have a visit from housekeeping to remove trash and sanitize your hot tub. Housekeeping will arrive between the hours of 11a.m. and 3p.m. Please place any trash in your outdoor receptacles before 11a.m.
- o Please bring beach towels to use after a soak in the hot tub

While we can be as thorough as possible, please continue to practice the CDC recommendations of 6 feet of social distancing and wearing masks should you choose to go out. You may want to avoid using the local grocery and bring your groceries with you to help reduce community shortages. Please wash your hands with soap and water frequently. If you feel sick or start running a fever please contact a local health provider and isolate yourself.

Currently the Stay Safe Ohio order requires persons entering the state with the intent to stay to self quarantine for 14 days. That does not mean you cannot rent a cabin, but during your stay you would need to stay in your cabin and not interact with public.
